




Trend in life expectancy, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2003-05 to 2018-20



Trend in life expectancy, female and male, Caerphilly wards and Wales, 2013-17*




Female and male healthy life expectancy at birth, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2018–20


Rate per 100 population, GP recorded chronic health conditions*, Caerphilly Middle Super Output Areas (MSOAs) and Wales, 2019







Rate per 100,00 population, Premature deaths (under age 75), Caerphilly MSOAs and Wales, 2009-18






Rate per 100,000 population (crude), cancer Incidence, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2010-12 to 2017-19




Rate per 100 population, GP recorded mental health condition, Caerphilly MSOAs and Wales, 2019







Age-standardised COVID-19 mortality rate per 100,000, by ethnic group, England and Wales, March 2020 to July 2020






Age-standardised COVID-19 mortality per 100,000, Gwent local authorities and Wales, March 2020-April 2021






Percent vaccinated with 2 doses and 2021/22 booster of COVID-19 vaccine, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2022


Rate per 1,000 live births, Infant deaths, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2019


Percent of low birthweight* full-term live babies, Caerphilly Wards and Wales, 2019







Percent of pupils aged 5-15 eligible for free school meals or transitionally protected, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2021/22






Percent of pupils aged 5-15 eligible for free school meals, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2012/13 to 2021/22






Percent of children aged 4 to 5 who are obese, Gwent local authorities and Aneurin Bevan UHB, 2020/21

Percent of children aged 4 to 5 who are obese by deprivation quintiles, Aneurin Bevan UHB, 2020/21





Percent of pupils achieving 5 GCSEs A* - C including English or Welsh, and Mathematics, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2018/19








Percent absent school sessions, aged 5-15, by free school meal status, Wales, 2022/23






Percent of half-day sessions missed due to all absences, secondary school, 2015/16-2018/19






Total spending on youth services, Gwent local authorities, 2010/11 to 2021/22






Number of learners in apprenticeships (all levels), Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2012/13 - 2021/22






Number of learners in Level 2 apprenticeships, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2012/13 - 2021/22






Number of learners in Level 3 apprenticeships, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2012/13 - 2021/22






Percent of population aged 16-64 with no qualifications, Caerphilly MSOAs and Wales, 2021 (not age-standardised)






Number of young people/children cautioned or sentenced, Gwent Youth Justice Service areas, 2013/14-2020/21






Rate per 1,000 women (aged 15-17), Under 18s conceptions, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2014-2021







Percent unemployed (ages 16-64), Gwent local authorities, Wales, and the United Kingdom, 2013 – 2022 (12 months ending)






Percent of claimants as a proportion of residents, 16-64 years, Caerphilly wards, Gwent, and Wales, 2022






Jobs per resident, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2021





Percent of adults aged 15-64 economically inactive due to long-term sickness, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2021/22




Percent of Adults (aged 16+) with certain conditions who are economically inactive, Caerphilly, 2020/21






Percent of Adults (aged 16+) with certain conditions who are economically inactive, Caerphilly, 2014-22






Percent of economically inactive adults who want a job by sex, age 16-64, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2021/22

Percent change in employment indexed to 2010, adults (16+), Gwent, 2010-21




Percent aged 16+ by type of employment*, Caerphilly, 2009-2021

Percent of those in employment who work mainly from home, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2021





Percent of children living in poverty, after housing costs, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2020/21






Percent of children in absolute low income families, before housing costs, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2020/21






Percent of children in absolute low income families, before housing costs, Gwent local authorities, Gwent, and Wales, 2014/15 – 2020/21


Percent of children in Absolute Low Income Families, Caerphilly wards, Caerphilly and Wales, 2021/22





Number of food parcels handed out to children and adults, Gwent local authorities, 2014/15 - 2021/22







Rate per 10,000 households




Percent of poor quality* houses, Caerphilly MSOAs and Wales, 2017/18







Excess winter mortality index*, with and without deaths due to COVID-19, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2019/20






The winter mortality index is expressed as a percentage, a winter mortality index of, for example, 20 shows that there were 20% more deaths in winter compared with the non-winter period.


Percent of all travelling to work, by method of travel, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2021







Average distance to nearest Park, Public Garden, or Playing Field, metres (m), Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2020






Percent of adults (16+) who feel lonely, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2021/22


Percent of older adults reporting a good level of life satisfaction, Gwent local authorities, Aneurin Bevan UHB and Wales, 2020/21







Percent people who agree that there is good community cohesion in their local area, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2016/17, 2018-19 and 2020/21






Percent of adults (aged 16+) who feel able to influence decisions affecting their local areas, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2021/22





Rate per 100 all crimes, Police recorded violent crime, Caerphilly MSOAs and Wales, 2019





Percent of overweight or obese adults (16+, BMI 25+), Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2018/19






Percent of pupils who did no frequent activity*, Gwent local authorities, Aneurin Bevan UHB and Wales, 2018


Percent of adults (16+) who meet the physical activity guidelines, Gwent local authorities, Aneurin Bevan UHB and Wales, 2020/21


Percent of adults (aged 16-64) drinking more than 14 units of alcohol in a usual week, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2016/17 - 2017/18

Rate per 100,000 population, Drug overdoses deaths (age-standardised), Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2019-21




Percent of population by ethnic group, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2021


Percent of pupils who are Black, Asian or from an ethnic minority group, primary and secondary schools, Gwent local authorities and Wales, 2021/22






